Dredging Project Starts

As a part of the upcoming dredging operations in Pelahatchie Bay, disposal areas for the dredged material are being constructed in the wooded areas along the north side of Spillway Road between Eagles Cove and Hwy 471. Debris from the logging of these disposal areas is currently being burned to clear the way for construction of the actual containment areas that will hold the sediment dredged from the lake. The burning has been planned under the supervision of a registered forester. They are being monitored to ensure they are conducted safely.
